Since January 2019, CREW Energy has developed a successful volunteer programme providing fuel poverty reduction advice to vulnerable communities across south London. Supported by a part-time staff member, we have a skilled and enthusiastic group of volunteers providing multilingual practical advice and support at face-to-face sessions (currently suspended) and by phone. We are looking to scale this service further to deepen our impact and expand our reach across vulnerable communities in London.

Prior to the pandemic, we had also begun to deliver sustainable education workshops to children and young people, using the Eco Action Games. Education has been deeply affected by the pandemic and we want to review how we can continue to deliver this work in 2021.

CREW Community trustees will build a sustainable organisation that ensures consistent and quality delivery of the charity's objectives.

We welcome all applications, we're particularly looking for applicants with prior experience/professional skills in fundraising, working with vulnerable communities, start-up development and volunteer management.
